As this time of year is upon us, we would like to share a few snow season safety reminders to keep all our family, friends and neighbors safe and healthy.

Snow Season Safety Reminders



Do not park along any roadway. The plow drivers need clear access to the roads for proper snow removal. (**The town right-of-way is 33 ft from the center of the road. With winter upon us, please have vehicles/personal property pushed back out of the right of way.)

PLOWING OR BLOWING SNOW INTO THE ROADS

Please do not snow blow or plow snow into the roadway, or across the roadway, as it is **<u>against the law</u>**. Most importantly, the excess snow you place in the road could cause someone to have a car accident. Let's keep our neighbors & family's safe this winter.

Snow Shoveling

There is always the dreaded task of shoveling – stairs, driveways, roofs, vehicles, etc. Some actually find shoveling cathartic. With that said we all know these activities can put a lot of strain on our bodies. Remember to listen to your body - take frequent rest periods, shovel smaller sections at a time, dress in layers so that you don't overheat, and stay hydrated. Keep an eye on your aging friends/neighbors/family – they may need a little extra help with their shoveling tasks!



2025 DOG LICENCE

<u>**Dog licenses**</u> are now available for the 2025-licensing year. Fees are <u>\$11</u> for unaltered/intact dogs and <u>\$6</u> for spayed/neutered dogs. You are required to license your dogs by <u>**December 31**st</u> <u>each year</u>. Don't be late; there is a \$25 late fee/per dog. Bring your pets updated rabies certificate with you to the town office.

<u>Burn Permits</u>

We are still getting called to outside fires that need to be permitted and are not. Burn Permits, as well as the information about when they are needed can be found at <u>Maineburnpermit.com</u>. Permits are FREE and it only takes a few minutes. A new requirement went into effect last year, if your fire is over 3 feet wide or 3 feet tall, you need a permit. Intent plays a lot in the need for a permit as well. If you are disposing of brush, or leaves, it requires a permit, even if you are doing it in a fire ring. Burning without a permit is a fineable offense....<u>so when in doubt please get a permit</u>.



STREET ADDRESSES IN TOWN

HELP US HELP YOU! Have you ever tried to determine what address you are at while driving the roads in town? Most roads have an average speed limit of 35 or 45 miles per hour. At these speeds numbers on a house that is set back off the road, undersized numbers on the mailbox, or numbers on the back side of the mailbox are hard to see and read. It is even more difficult when a house has none of these. It is not infrequent to see emergency vehicles have to turn around because they have passed the address of the emergency. Help us by posting clearly visible numbers, preferably 3 inch or larger, and reflective on both sides of your mail box. If you do not have a mail box, a sign post at the edge of the road is preferred. Although E-911 signs through the county are no longer available, similar signs can be purchased on line,

or at local home improvement stores for a reasonable cost. *MINUTES CAN MATTER IN AN EMERGENCY, SO PLEASE HELP EMERGENCY RESPONDERS FIND YOUR HOME THE FIRST TIME!*
